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## ABSTRACT

This research brief from Miami-Dade Community College (Florida) addresses fundable outcomes for workforce development. Workforce development funding depends on the ability to earn 'points' for completions and placements. Miami-Dade Community College produced 7,542 fundable outcomes for 1999-2000, compared with 3,966 for 1998-1999. These included 2,039 graduates; 3,603 occupational or literacy completion points; and 1,900 placements. The increase in numbers for 1999-2000 was due to the reporting of completion points. By program category, Associate in Science programs produced 2,189 fundable outcomes, 42 fewer than last year. Credit certificate programs produced 158 outcomes, 17 more than last year. Vocational Certificate programs produced 2,388 fundable outcomes (1,061 were occupational completion points), which was 908 more than last year. Adult Basic and GED programs produced 2,807 fundable outcomes (2,542 were literacy completion points), which was 2,693 more than last year. The largest number of outcomes and largest increase was for the School of Community Education, where literacy completion points were captured for 1999-2000. The School of Business and Computer Information Systems now ranks second in outcomes, and also showed an increase due to occupational completion points for vocational certificates reported in 1999-2000. ## Fundable Outcomes for Workforce Development

### Summary

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**Workforce development funding depends on our ability to earn 'points' for completions and placements. Miami-Dade Community College produced 7,542 fundable outcomes for 1999-00 compared to 3,966 for 1998-99. These included: 2,039 graduates; 3,603 occupational or literacy completion points; and 1,900 placements. Clearly the increase in numbers for 1999-00 was due to the reporting of completion points.**

**By program category, Associate in Science programs produced 2,189 fundable outcomes, 42 fewer than last year. Credit certificate programs produced 158 outcomes, 17 more than last year. Vocational Certificate programs produced 2,388 fundable outcomes (1,061 were occupational completion points), which are 908 more than last year. Adult Basic and GED programs produced 2,807 fundable outcomes (2,542 were literacy completion points), which are 2,693 more than last year.**

### Introduction

Workforce funding depends, in part, on completions and job placement of students. The state withholds a portion of our base allocation that we must earn back with these 'fundable outcomes'. The actual workforce formula involves point values for different program types, student types, and placement levels, plus a weighting for area unemployment. The point values and weights are changing again this year. In order to present stable data from one year to the next, the attached tables report fundable outcomes and not the points generated.

### Outcomes by School

Table 1 shows the fundable outcomes by school for 1998-99 and 1999-00. Schools are sorted based on 1999-00 fundable outcomes. The outcomes data are from prior year performances. Thus 1999-00 outcomes include placement of 1997-98 graduates and completions for 1998-99. Data for 1999-00 also include placements added through the efforts of School Directors, and completion points captured by Institutional Research programming. The largest number of outcomes and largest increase is for the School of Community Education, where literacy completion points (LCPs) were captured for 1999-00. The School of Business and Computer Information Systems now ranks second in outcomes, and also shows an increase due to occupational completion points (OCPs) for vocational certificates (PSAV) reported in 1999-00. These increases are mirrored at the bottom of Table 1 where data are summarized by degree/certificate type.

Since schools may have many or few programs, Table 2 shows outcomes per program

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for each school, with A.S. and certificates listed separately. Again the schools are sorted based on 1999-00 outcomes. For A.S. programs, the schools of Nursing (176.5 outcomes per program) and Education (118 outcomes per program) head the list with more than double the outcomes per program of the other schools. The schools of Allied Health, Criminal Justice, and Business & Computers form another cluster with 40-50 outcomes per program. The remaining schools have fewer than 20 outcomes per program, but most show an increase.

The School of Criminal Justice heads the list for certificate programs, with 215.8 outcomes per program. This volume is due primarily to the Correctional Officer and Law Enforcement Officer programs. Business & Computers ranks next, with 83.8 outcomes per program (64 more than in 1998-99). The increase is primarily due to OCPs. Allied Health credit certificates rank next with 75.5 outcomes per program. However, all of the outcomes were produced by the Paramedic program.

Tables 3 and 4 expand the data to show placements, graduates, and OCPs separately as outcomes. Table 4 shows these outcomes per program for each school. Finally, Table 5 shows outcomes for each program and is left for the reader to examine.

## Methodology

Data for this report were obtained from the Division of Community Colleges by special request and entered into the attached spreadsheets. Programs are identified at the state level by CIP code, and thus 'options' within a M-DCC program are collapsed into a single CIP. The 1999-00 data were verified against local files for graduates and placements.
