ABSTRACT

South Dakota Career Education has prepared an abbreviated bibliography for school counselors that will complement materials recommended elsewhere in the Shoppers Guide.

It has not been the policy of South Dakota Career Education to suggest a separate guidance course, - we have instead recommended that guidance activities be integrated into established curriculum when appropriate. Material, such as audio-visual software, simulations and games, and assorted printed material, suitable to group guidance can be found elsewhere in the Shoppers Guide.

The guidance bibliography is divided into three sections; literature on career guidance, counseling and placement for the counselor's professional library, guidance material for a student library, and counseling and guidance professional journals. Each listing contains the publishers address and, wherever possible, the purchase price of the item.

PLACEMENT AND FOLLOW-UP IN CAREER EDUCATION: Buckingham and Lee

The state of the art of placing students in institutions of higher learning is fairly well advanced, but experience in placing students in employment and following students after they leave an institution is still largely undeveloped. The individual results of education and training are not, as a rule, known by most school administrators and teachers. Critical reappraisals of instructional systems are seldom based on the results achieved. Only in recent years has the systematic follow-up of students in vocational education begun to be developed, and the literature here is meager and far from satisfactory. Career education must develop placement and follow-up procedures, consistent with its central purpose, which are largely without precedent.

Subtitled, "Who Needs It, Who Provides It, Who Can Improve It" is an in-depth study of career guidance. It was compiled under the direction of Eli Ginzberg, Director of the Conservation of Human Resources, Columbia University, and Chairman of the National Manpower Advisory Committee for the last nine years. For three years, a group of experts on the Conservation of Human Resources Project headed by Ginzberg - the country's leading manpower specialist - reviewed the entire field. The Rockefeller Brothers Fund sponsored the study. In addition to their own research, the Columbia team consulted with the leaders of the guidance profession, educators and government officials, before finalizing their recommendations.

In the final section of the book the authors set forth their recommendations to the guidance profession, the agencies that employ counselors, and the public that supports them about how the guidance field can be strengthened so that it is able to deliver on the promises which it has made to help every individual use his opportunities so as to realize his potentials.
