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ABSTRACT

This catalog provides information on software for counselors and student services personnel, arranged according to counseling and student development topics. The areas covered by the catalog include administrative aids, athletics, career development, counseling, financial aid, health services, statistical programs, student activities, and testing. There are also sections on databases, electronic mail, software available in the public domain, publications for computer users, and software directories. Software programs are listed alphabetically by title under the appropriate heading, and include a description and information on system requirements (hardware, operating system), price, and publisher. The catalog also contains a Software Review Form (for listed programs) and a Software Submission Form (for suggested additions). (JAC)

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Many people have worked hard to make this document a reality. Sponsored by the Ontario College counselors, it was entitled, "Software and Resource Catalog", and was published in March 1983.

The response to the first catalog was extremely positive, both in the number of copies requested by interested professionals, and in the number of software descriptions contributed by counselors using computers. As a result, the Student Development Software Clearinghouse grew into a formal non-profit project sponsored by Commission I of the American College Personnel Association and the W.K. Kellogg Foundation's Project LEARN. ACPA Commission I assumed responsibility for developing the next edition of the catalog and assigned the project to the Task Force on Microcomputer Applications to Student Development. Russ Watjersheaded the project, with James Blakly again a major contributor. Michele Stevens also deserves special recognition for her assumed in publicizing and promoting the software clearinghouse.

As the amount of information grew, it became obvious that a comprehensive system was needed to manage the data and to provide a means for continual updating. Martha Watjen, who has a background in both systems analysis and student development, developed this system using dBase II. The data were entered by students at Western Connecticut State University, supervised by Alice Fernandes.

Maintaining such a database and periodically publishing updated versions, however, are major tasks that cannot easily be handled strictly on a volunteer basis. Therefore, ACPA Commission I and Project LEARN have established on ongoing collaboration with the ERIC Clearinghouse on Counseling and Point need the current document was performed by the staff of the ERIC Clearinghouse on Counseling and Personnel Services, to which Mary C. Frenza, Assistant Director, made a significant contribution.

Even with the massive efforts put forth in compiling the information and publishing this catalog, the <u>substance</u> of the catalog derives from the contributions of practicing counselors and student development specialists. Therefore, we want to express our particular appreciation to those who have been willing to take the time to share the software resources they have found to be useful in their own counseling settings.

We are pleased with the opportunity to assist in the production of this catalog and excited about the opportunity for future collaboration with ACPA Commission I in the planning and development of our expanded version. STATE OF THE ART IN COUNSELING AND STUDENT DEVELOPMENT SOFTWARE

Garry R. Watz and Jeanne Blever

We have been very impressed by the prodigious effort that has gone into the initial development of this catalog and see it as a significant contribution to the facilitation of greater utilization of computers and technology in counseling and student development. Such a document as this not only meets our immediate needs of finding an appropriate piece of software for a given task, but provides a window on the larger questions of where we have been and where we are going in terms of future developments. We are able to select, as a gourmet might, the entrees which would most satisfy us for the present, as well as to conjure up what we would like our chefs to be thinking about and preparing for us for the future.

As we reviewed and analyzed the software base, our reactions and conclusions were developed more as an additive synthesis than a systematic and actuarial accounting. We are interested more in the artist's broad brush strokes than the minute details of the fine touch-up to the finished canvas, and our goal is more to encourage discussion and reflection on the thoughts and images we suggest than to provide definitive and factual conclusions. Hopefully, our thoughts will not only provide some meaningful generalizations about what we have achieved so far, but also encourage compelling images of what we can and should do for the future.

Our first observation is the extent to which we appear to rely on general purpose software in the field of counseling and student development. Clearly, the largest amount of software available to us would fall into the general areas of wordprocessing, spreadsheets, and database management. This predilection for a generic use and development of software has advantages and disadvantages. General purpose software provides more assistance in the management of counsel-



ing and student development than it does in the delivery of services. Thus, it may implicitly suggest that computers are to be used more as supportive administrative tools than for direct assistance in counseling. On the other hand, if it is, in fact, a time-saving administrative tool, it has the potential to minimize the inevitable conflicts regarding time and priorities. How m my of us wouldn't like to have more time, away from the desk and our administrative and management tasks, to spend in direct and meaningful interaction with students? It also needs to be emphasized that general purpose software is available at several levels of sophistication for almost all types of computers and is extremely cost-effective because it can be used for many different applications. Even though some special purpose software programs appear to be less expensive, their use, in the long run, may be more costly because of the need to purchase a separate program disk for each task. Learning to use general purpose software is not a difficult task and does not require programining expertise. The creative user can capitalize on the flexibility of general purpose software and develop administrative tools that are highly customized for a specific setting. Improvement in the management phase of counseling and student development is one area that almost all people in the helping services can profit by, and the judicious use of general purpose software can be a most valuable contribution to this area.

The use of students to write computer programs for specific student development applications is a clear trend. Because students are well-versed in computer programming and filled with zest and interest in applying their skills to student development, the student-designed software is frequently appealing because of its freshness and appropriateness for specific student development needs. On the less positive side, it is often ignored after its original development, and it becomes very hard to maintain and update the software after a student author has left or moved on to other interests. Documentation of the software clearly appears to be of

prime importance with reference to student programs. At the minimum, we need to systematically collect data relative to the use and outcomes of the program and to provide comprehensive and accurately updated manuals about how the specific software should be used.

There appears to be an increasing emphasis on the distinction between commercially developed software and that which is done as part of a project or an ongoing internal program activity. This may be due to a distrust of commercial profit motives, but the feeling may be ill-founded and inappropriate given that commerical developers are more likely to have the resources and the technical expertise needed to originate quality software and to insure its continuing development and refinement. On the other hand, commercial developers may lack the theoretical grounding necessary to produce good special purpose software for use in counseling and student development. What appears to be ideal is the combination of experienced and knowledgeable counseling and student development persons with commercial programmers to create software which is both professionally sound and technically sophisticated. Good tests need to be both reliable and valid, and the old saying, "You can't have validity without reliability," may apply to the software field as well. Unless the programs work and are free of the operational bugs that can interfere with their successful application, the best ideas and thoughts in the world will go awry. Perhaps one important outcome of this catalog will be the systematic collection of user thoughts about existing software and their preferences for future developments. This information can then be shared with commercial software developers to bring about this best of all marriages: professional knowledge and technical competence.

There is an old adage in testing and measurement that the best tests are the old tests. The thinking behind this is that the utility of tests is determined by the normative data that are available and the collected experiences regarding their



usefulness in a wide variety of situations. Older tests also have a great deal of research associated with them regarding their correlation with other measures and their ability to predict certain events and outcomes. New tests, on the other hand, leave the user almost totally dependent upon the author's claims, often highly exaggerated and illusory. The same situation would seem to apply to the software field. As a given program is used, we learn not only about its technical quality, but also about its success in meeting the needs of a wide range of users, from the counselor or student development specialist to the student or adult client. Systematically collected, these data can be extremely helpful to potential users. In attempting to make decisions about the desirability of one piece of software versus another, most users are clearly looking for what the program offers to specific clients and what kinds of outcomes can reasonably be expected. Information of this sort can be extremely useful in choosing among software alternatives and in deciding how we might best use it. At this point, this catalog does not contain evaluative reviews. Moreover, we must again stress the fact that inclusion of material in this catalog does not constitute an approval or endorsement of the products or services described. In its present form, the database is relatively primitive in that it is simply an organized collection of counselor-nominated It is our hope, however, that as people use the various resources identified in this document, they will contribute their experiences, observations, and recommendations as requested in the section, "Using This Catalog" (page 1).

It is becoming increasingly clear that the most successful and satisfied users of computers in counseling and student development are those who are able to make creative applications of the software, frequently going beyond its originally intended use. As poor media can sometimes be turned into effective instructional tools, the utility of software may be a function more of the user's creativity and resourcefulness than of the program's intrinsic quality. We need to strive for

quality software, but we also need to have a parallel emphasis on more imaginative and ingenious uses. Imaginativeness in the use of software can not only make good software more effective, but also lead to the development of more creative and compelling programs in the future. An example of what we are thinking of is the use of fantasy games similar to "Dungeons and Dragons" to promote problemsolving and teamwork among individuals as a response to complex life situations. The interaction between players and the post-game discussion of strategies and behaviors can be most helpful in helping individuals see that the roles they play in the games have parallels in real life. Much can be learned in such gaming situations regarding people's natural inclinations toward strategies, risk-taking and systematic approaches to information-gathering before making decisions. Numerous programs also lend themselves to teamwork, as in the survival games where the response is not that of an individual, but a group consensus.

The largest number of programs in this catalog fall into the category, "Administrative Aids." This tends to be a catch-all but, as emphasized previously, does give major focus to the management phase of counseling and student development. Interestingly, the predominance of programs in this area suggests that they are more readily developed than programs designed for direct student or client use, which is probably true. On the other hand, it may also suggest that we, as professionals committed to the personal factor in counseling and student development activities, are more convinced of the suitability of computer-managed counseling than of computer-assisted counseling. For further clarification on this distinction, see Bleuer and Walz, "Counselors and Computers," an ERIC/CAPS Fact Sheet (free on request).

The second-largest category is career development and placement. The rapid development of materials in this area and the abundance of information about occupations and educational opportunities may help to account for its strong



emphasis. Perhaps one of the fastest growing types of software is the interactive program for student users that covers the gamut from values and life styles to learning and study skills. As part of an overall program of computer enhanced counseling and student development, these topic-focused software programs have a great deal of potential. When appropriately interwoven into the larger program of assistance to students, they may result in major increases in our ability to help students with planning and decision making.

In summation, it seems that as a result of our review of the software, we have identified several imperatives. First, we need to systematically collect data about who has used what program, for what purpose, and with what results. Related to that, we need to know what aspects the user was pleased with and what problems the user encountered. Secondly, we need to become not only a collection source, but a source for greater creativity and imaginaton in the use of computers and software. Some of the truly significant uses of computers in counseling and student development will clearly be in the interface between different types of technology and in the creative uses of software programs. Teaming, group problem solving, the creation of learning climates, and user-designed programs are just some of the promising areas for this sort of use. They are more likely to come about with increased sharing of specific information about peopid's innovative and novel uses of software.

Third, we need to pinpoint areas where counseling and student development software needs to be developed, particularly of the interactive variety. Having identified the areas that have high priority, we can then encourage their development both by individual entrepreneurs and by commercial concerns. Competition and duplication in this broad arena has clearly led to improved software. We need to bring as much zesty interaction and competition between developers in this field as possible. Multiple sources of development may be the best real way to under-

write quality assurance in software program development. Lastly, we feel that one of the most meaningful contributions this catalog can make is to convey a sense of excitement to potential users about both the quantity and the quality of available software and also the need for all counselors and student personnel to become more actively involved. The resources are there. The challenge for us is not only to use it, but to use it in more ingenious and creative ways.
