## ABSTRACT

This is a report on the 2001 after-college earnings of students from Washington State's community and technical colleges. The state board created a wage-based category system for all 500 vocational/job-preparatory programs offered by the 34 state two-year colleges. The programs were divided into high- (\$12 or more per hour), middle- (\$10.50-\$12 per hour), and low-wage (under \$10.50 per hour) job-preparatory programs, based on the hourly wage rate for all completers in a particular program. The system is useful in monitoring the equity of enrollment and completion in the high-wage versus the low-wage programs by race and/or gender. The 1998-99 results showed that: (1) 46% of community and technical college completers were in high-wage programs; (2) African Americans were the least likely (37%) to be completers in high-wage programs; and (3) computer technology, engineering technology, and health-related programs such as nursing, dental hygienist, and physical therapy, were among the most common high-wage programs. The appendix provides a listing of all 500 job-preparatory programs. (MKF)

## **HIGH-, MIDDLE-, AND LOW-WAGE JOB PREPARATORY PROGRAMS – THE CREATION AND USE OF POLICY TOOL BASED ON UI WAGES DATA**

May 2001

**Overview:** Researchers have shown that after-college earnings vary by field of study. Consistent with that notion, the Washington State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC) researchers created a wage-based category system for all 500 of the state community and technical college programs. State policy leaders have used this three-part system – high-, middle-, and low-wage programs – to monitor progress on key policy issues over the past three years. Specifically, the category system is used to monitor the equity of enrollment and completion in the high-wage versus the low-wage programs by race and ethnic category and by gender. The system is also used to monitor the extent to which college programs are increasingly focused on higher-wage programs in response to external expectations.

This report provides an appendix showing three levels of aggregation of job preparatory programs by CIP. It also provides the steps followed to use Unemployment Insurance data (UI data) to create the groups.

**Literature:** The NCES analysis of the 1991 Recent College Graduate Survey shows a distinctly different employment and earnings pattern by student major (U.S. Department of Education, OERI, 1993). Those graduating from health related programs earned \$31,500 one year after graduation. Those leaving with humanities degrees earned \$19,100. The work of Grubb using the Survey of Income and Program Participation (SIPP) suggests that a similar pattern applies in community and technical colleges (1999).

**UI wage information:** The prerequisite is wage data for students. Since 1987 the SBCTC has linked the records of former students from all the colleges with those of the state's Employment Security Department (ESD). This data matching process evolved to become a partnership with other state workforce programs and agencies. A third party vendor translates the ESD data into a format that meets the requirements of the partner's common data standards and is easy to use (Microsoft Access format). The data set includes information on each student's college attendance and pre-, during- and post-college employment. Employment data includes the total quarterly earnings, the industry of the main employer (using SIC), and the county where the student is employed.

This information is not unique to Washington. It is available in all UI systems. What is unique to Washington is the availability of hours worked and hourly wage in the quarter. Although similar information is not currently available in most other states, researchers can substitute monthly earnings (quarterly earnings divided by three).

We have elected to describe median earnings, wage and hour data rather than the mean. Earnings and, to a lesser extent, hours do not follow a normal curve. We often look at earnings over time so it is important to look at inflation-adjusted data. To meet that need each record includes both the actual hourly wage rate and quarterly earnings, and inflation-adjusted wages and earnings (using the implicit price deflator to translate into a 1992 value). Researchers then use a table of price factors to translate the stored 1992 value into current inflation-adjusted value. (Seppanen, 1998)

**Creating the categories:** The goals for creating the categories were to create a system that was more manageable than the 500 individual program CIPs, and that was simpler to communicate to various stakeholders.

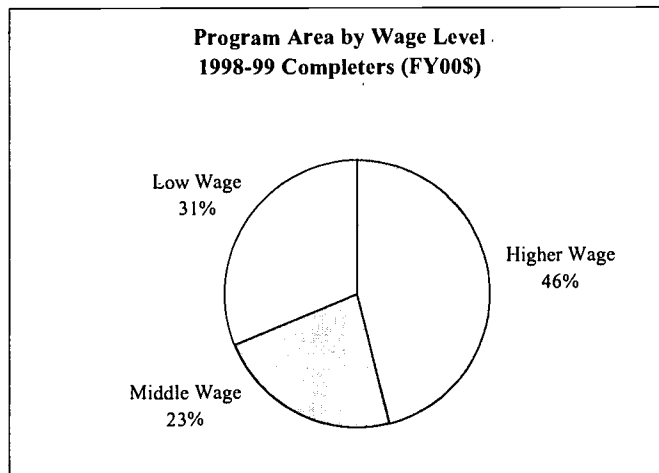
The steps used to create the categories during 1995-96 were:

- Using hourly rates for all completers by CIP from the UI data match, the initial lowest level aggregation was based on groupings used for earlier versions of Carl Perkins reporting.
- The hourly rates for program CIPs were associated with each of the Carl Perkins categories.
- The next step required detailed analysis of each lowest level CIP category. The goal was to have at least 40 students in each group to insure stability in the median wage from year to year. Also completers in each aggregation needed to have similar hourly earnings pattern—not significantly higher nor lower than the other programs in the aggregate category. In some instances, there were enough students in a single CIP, such as ADN nursing, to warrant a separate category. In other instances, the individual programs were too small and were aggregated in "Other" categories. This process created the first level of aggregation.
- The second level of aggregation continued the process of grouping. The third and highest level of aggregation--high-, medium-, and low-wage categories--was based on natural groupings of hourly rates. The cutoff demarking high to middle and middle to low is somewhat arbitrary.

**Validating the categories:** Westat, a third-party contractor, validated the lowest level of aggregation when it used the categories to conduct a Net Impact Study in 1997 (see <http://www.wa.gov/wtb/westat.html>). This study found that those enrolled in low wage programs experienced a negative net impact from college going, and all others had the expected positive net impact.

In 2000, the Washington Workforce Training and Education Coordinating Board (WTECB) reviewed the categories including data from other sectors (private career schools and high school vocational programs). The WTECB disaggregated some categories, but in general validated the system.

**Monitor Enrollment and Completion:** Washington has a strong focus on increasing the role of community and technical colleges in offering high-wage programs. This category system is used to monitor the extent to which completers are from high-, middle-, and low-wage programs. Over time the high-wage percentage has increased from 44 to 46 percent. The aggregation apply to some 14,000 annual job preparatory completers. Completers include graduates with degrees and certificates, apprentice completers, completers from unique programs (Exit Code 9), and those who leave programs with 45 or more vocational credits but no degree or certificate. Some 46 percent of completers got their training in programs categorized as high-wage programs where the typical completer (median wage) earns more than \$12 an hour. These are regarded as high-wage occupational programs compared to the middle- (\$10.50 - \$12) and lower-wage programs (under \$10.50 an hour), that account for 23 percent (middle) and 31 percent (low).



**Not All Programs Have Equal Benefits.** In using data from the longitudinal Survey of Income and Program Participant data, Grubb (1995) showed that some programs of study appeared to provide no gain for students. In Washington, we have come to the common understanding that what students earn depends a good deal on their program of study. The wages for each program of study may be related to labor market factors rather than program quality. We have not yet formed a common view that the programs with lower earnings are a sign of no gain for the students, though there is some evidence to that effect (Westat, 1997). (Seppanen, 1998).

The table on the next page shows the distribution of graduates by lowest level aggregation.

Over the past four years, while the median earnings for all these programs have climbed, the relative place on the low to high-wage list has changed only for a small number of programs. The protective service programs, for example, moved up the middle-wage to high-wage list over time as the programs were better aligned with employment in the state's prisons.

**Equity:** The category system is used to monitor the state's equity goal related to enrollment and completion in the high-wage versus the low-wage programs by race and ethnic category. Students of color are underrepresented but increasing in percentage in the high-wage programs and over represented in the low-wage programs. The State Board has set a goal to increase that percentage to equity with white students.

African American and Native American students completing vocational programs are less likely than whites to be completers in the higher wage occupational areas. The pattern has improved for all groups of color however.

The category system is being used as an additional approach that goes beyond the Carl Perkins Non-traditional indicator. In this case the percentage of women in high-wage programs is monitored. Staff working with women's programs have established a goal to increase the representation of women in high-wage programs to equity with men.
