ABSTRACT

Based on data provided by college districts to the California Community Colleges' Office of the Chancellor, this report provides information on the number of degrees and certificates awarded by the state's community colleges in 1994-95. Following introductory materials, four tables are provided showing the number of degrees and certificates awarded by college, providing information on Associate of Arts (AA) and Associate of Science (AS) degrees and certificates by the number of credits earned; awards by gender by college; awards by ethnicity by college; and degrees and certificates awarded by discipline. Highlighted findings include the following: (1) 53,465 AA and AS degrees and 24,216 certificates were awarded during the 1994-95 academic year; (2) of the certificates awarded, 10,719 (44%) required the equivalent of three semesters in length, or 30 to 60 credit units; (3) women earned 60% (n=45,783) of the degrees and certificates; (4) White students earned 41,770 (54%) of the awards, Hispanic students earned 12,532 (16%), Asian students earned 9,754 (13%), and Black students earned 5,203 (7%); (5) Liberal Arts and Science majors received the highest percentage of the degrees awarded at 34%, followed by General Studies majors who earned 9%; and (6) the highest percentage of certificates earned were in nursing related disciplines at 10.8% and administration of justice at 8.3%. Preface

This is the third annual report on the number of degrees and certificates awarded by California community colleges. In this start-up year, separate reports were also prepared for the 1992-93 and 1993-94 academic years. This report is based on data provided by districts to the Chancellor's Office Management Information System (COMIS) for the following data elements (as defined in the Data Element Dictionary):

SP01	Student Program Identifier
SP02	Student Program Award
SB04	Student Gender
SB05	Student Ethnicity
GI01	District-College Identifier
GI03	Term Identifier

The purpose of this report is two-fold. First, it provides feedback to districts and colleges on data reported through the COMIS process. Local staff should verify that the numbers shown here accurately reflect their college's actual performance. Any errors or omissions detected should be corrected in current and future data submissions. Second, it serves as a reference document on how well colleges are doing in awarding degrees and certificates. Increasingly, state and federal accountability reports are focusing on degrees and certificates awarded as an important performance based measure. It is hoped that annual publication of these data will not only improve reporting, but also encourage colleges to use the information in their institutional planning and review processes such as: program review; student equity; educational master planning; and accreditation.

There are four tables to this report, the first display is for total number of degrees and certificates (by length) offered by each college. The second display breaks down the number of degrees and certificates by gender for each college. The third display shows the number of degrees and certificates by ethnicity for each college. The last display has the statewide number of degrees and certificates awarded by six digit TOP Code.

Leonard Shymoniak, of the Accountability Unit, prepared the software programs, edited the data, and produced the summary tables. Tom Nobert, of the Management Information Services Unit, generated the necessary files used to produce this report. Adria Sanders, of the Documents and Publication Unit, assisted in the format, layout, and preparation.

Executive Summary

During the 1994-95 academic year, California community colleges awarded a total 53,465 Associate of Arts/Science (AA/AS) degrees and another 24,216 Certificates of Completion. Colleges awarding the largest number of AA/AS degrees included San Francisco (1,750), DeAnza (1,297), El Camino (1,285), Ranch Santiago (1,279), Fresno City (1,206), Santa Rosa (1,138), Cerritos (1,082), Mt. San Antonio (1,078), and Fullerton (1,037).

Of the certificates awarded, 10,719 (44%) required the equivalent of three semesters in length (30 to 60 credit units), followed by 8,349 (34%) of two semesters in length (15 to 29 credit units), and 3,290 (14%) of four or more semesters (60+ credit units) in length.

More women than men earned degrees and certificates. Women earned 45,783 (60%) of the degrees and certificates awarded compared to 31,072 (40%) for men (after proration of unknowns).

The number of degrees and certificates earned by race/ethnic categories were: Whites, 41,770 (54%); Hispanics, 12,532 (16%); Asians, 9,754 (13%); and Blacks, 5,203 (7%).
