Thank you for your inquiry about the <u>Certificate in Health Informatics-Administration</u>. Below is an outline of the courses in the Certificate. To apply for the Certificate, you must complete two things:

- Complete the online application to CSUN found at: www.csumentor.edu The instructions for applying for the Certificate, through CSUmentor, are below. Currently A&R only support Fall application, however if you are interested in a Spring admission contact Dr. Brian Malec (See below.)
- Complete the Information Forum that is on this website and send it to the address on the Forum.

There are five courses in the Certificate in Health Informatics-Administration. We focus on more management issues rather than medical records.

- Fall semester HSCI 505A Health Informatics we build the base of health data and data analytics
- Spring semester we have teamed with the College of Business two deliver two courses:
 - o IS 531 Health-Systems Analysis and Design
 - o IS 551 Health-Project Management
- Summer session HSCI 515 Seminar in Health Information Technology. We cover leadership and management issues of HIT and the evolving health policy changes in healthcare delivery: tele-medicine, population health, EMRs and other current topics.
- We have a field project that we can fit in over the Fall or Spring semesters that teams up a student with an IT professional to do a consulting orientated project
- All the courses are offered once a year so it could take up to three semesters and a summer to complete.

All these courses are face-to-face (expect the field project). All the courses are graduate level and are taken by certificate and non-certificate students. All the courses are acceptable as electives in the MBA or MSHA. So, for some students they take the certificate courses concurrent as electives in their masters. For others they just take the certificate courses independently.
