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ABSTRACT

This report consists of nine tables that present statistical information submitted by California public schools, school districts, and county superintendents of schools during the fall of 1980. Public school employees actuded in this report are certified fulltime and parttime personnel and noncertified personnel serving at the level of superintendent and deputy, associate, and assistant superintendent. Professional staff in adult education programs, preschools, and child care centers are excluded, as are short-term substitute teachers. The first seven tables are broken down by teaching assignment (grade level and subject area) and by titles of norteaching personnel. These tables show: (1) racial or ethnic heritage and sex; (2) highest education level attained; (3) percent of staff having tenure or fulltime, parttime, temporary, probationary, or substitute status; (4) age categories; (5) years of experience in the district; (6) total years of educational service; and (7) number of positions and average salary. The eighth table summarizes the findings in the previous seven tables according to size of school district staff. The ninth table supplies the average and number (fulltime equivalents) of staff by the type of school district--elementary, unified, high school, or other. (FG)

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INTRODUCTION

The information contained in this report was collected through the California Basic Educational Data System (CBEDS). Included are data submitted by public schools, school districts, and offices of county superintendents of schools in the fall, 1980. The report describes characteristics of professional staff members in public elementary and secondary education in California.

Professional staff members include certificated personnel employed full-time or part-time and noncertificated personnel serving at the level of superintendent, deputy superintendent, associate superintendent, or assistant superintendent. Professional staff in adult education programs, preschools, and child care centers are excluded from this group, as are short-term substitute teachers.

The professional staff characteristics contained in this report are racial or ethnic group, sex, highest educational level, age, years of experience in the district, total years of educational service, type of appointment, and salary.

"Highest educational level" refers to the traditional academic degrees, with 30 semester hour increments. There is no provision for showing other levels, such as "master's degree, plus 45 hours." "Years of experience in the district" excludes employment as a substitute teacher and any other noncontracted position. "Total years of educational service" includes service in a school district or office of a county superintendent of schools as well as in other states and countries but excludes time spent as a substitute, on a leave of absence, or in noneducational employment.

The information in this report is based on 217,686 records, 80 percent of which were reported by individual professional staff members and 20 percent of which were reported by school districts from central office files. Data for all but three of the characteristics reported were complete for 97 percent of the records. "Age," "years of experience in the district," and "type of appointment" (turned, probationary, long-term substitute or temporary, or other) were not reported for staff in two large school districts. Consequently, data for these three variables were complete for 85 percent of the records.

Percents reported in the following tables may not add to 100 due to rounding. Average salaries and full-time equivalents reported here may differ slightly from those published in other documents because of their combination with selected variables.

Tables 1 through 7 show characteristics for professional staff based on their assignments, along with a statewide summary for professional staff.

Individual staff members may have been counted in more than one assignment group. For example, a teacher whose assignment includes courses in both social science and English would be counted in the analysis for each subject area. However, "salary" statistics (Table 7) were computed on the basis of full-time equivalency. If a person taught in two assignment areas, such as social studies and English, that persons's salary would be proportionally distributed to each of the subject areas. In the list of assignments, it should be noted that the Characteristics of teaching staff in schools that offer departmentalized instruction, particularly in grades seven and eight, are reported in the subject areas.

Table 8 displays characteristics of professional staff in various sizes of school districts, including offices of county superintendents of schools and regional occupational programs. The size of school district was defined as the number of professional staff employed. State summaries are also provided.

Table 9 shows average salaries and the full-time-equivalent professional staff employed in different types of school districts.

Similar analyses of staff characteristics for selected counties or districts in the state may be requested from the Department of Education for the cost of production.
