ABSTRACT

This paper was submitted to Our Lady of the Lake College as an independent study project in Library Science. It covers the 1125 LI documents listed in "Research in Education" from March 1971-April 1972 and focuses attention on the 169 which are not available from the EDRS. It briefly discusses the relative difficulty of obtaining non EDRS LI documents and aims at reducing the difficulty and increasing the control over the non EDRS LI document. Four tables present information which can be used to better control these documents. Table 1 lists the documents by ED number and notes those that are available from the National Technical Information Service, those that are listed in "Library Literature" ERIC/CLIS Lists and those on hand and on order for Our Lady of the Lake College Library. The other three tables use complete bibliographic citations to list the entire 169 non EDRS LI documents and the hardcopy holdings and on order lists of these 169 documents at Our Lady of the Lake College Library. This paper will be especially useful to scholarly libraries that require good control of ERIC/CLIS holdings.

The ERIC/CLIS documents which are abstracted in "Document Resumes" of Research in Education can be divided into two discrete categories: Those documents that are available from the ERIC Document Reproduction Service (EDRS) and those documents that are not available from EDRS. The documents that are available from the EDRS can be purchased in microfiche form for \$0.65 each, using standing order procedures. These documents should present few acquisition problems to the scholarly library that has responsibility for holding current research literature in library science. In the alternative case, when a document is not available from the EDRS, individual attention and acquisition is required, costs vary, sources differ, and in general it is obviously more difficult for the scholarly library to obtain complete holdings of this library science material. My purpose is to reduce the level of difficulty in accessing and obtaining LI (Library and Information Science) numbered ERIC/CLIS documents which are not available from the EDRS for the period, March 1970 through April 1972 by studying these documents.

I used the resources of Our Lady of the Lake College Library at San Antonio, Texas to perform this study. Their library has both a scholarly library science collection and a large microfiche collection of EDRS documents. The Research in Education abstracts of LI documents not available from the EDRS were collected from

twenty-six monthly volumes and alphabetized by main entry. These abstracts were checked against the main dictionary catalog at the library. Holdings of the library were noted. Next, the library science order file was checked for these abstracts and these were noted also. Next, the abstracts were separated by "available from source" into two discrete groups. Those available from the National Technical Information Service and those available from other sources. These differences were noted. Then the abstracts were rearranged by ERIC ED number and the microfiche collection was searched for each document.

These procedures provided specific information which may be used to reduce the level of difficulty of obtaining LI documents which are not available from the EDRS for the period, March 1970 through April 1972. This data is displayed in the following four tables. Table 1 lists all document abstracts used, by ERIC ED number and date of the Research in Education abstract. Table 2 is an alphabetical listing of all of the abstracts using information available from the Research in Education abstract to form a bibliographic citation. The ERIC main entry is retained and only a few minor changes are made to the entries. Table 3 is the listing of holdings of the Our Lady of the Lake College Library. Table 4 is the Library Science on order list for Our Lady of the Lake College Library. Format and terms are explained at the end of Table 1 and 2. A discussion of the data follows Table 4.

How can this information be used to reduce the level of difficulty in obtaining non EDRS LI documents? Table 1 is a checklist for holders of ERIC microfiche documents. It should be used to authenticate local non-availability of non EDRS microfiche documents. Table 2 is a checklist for hardcopy availability in scholarly library science collections. Tables 3 and 4 are specifically prepared for use at Our Lady of the Lake College Library, and are designed to permit annotation of "ERIC/CLIS Accession" lists in Library Literature as to local availability or planned availability of non EDRS LI documents. Table 1 may also be used to annotate Research in Education abstracts as to availability of non EDRS LI documents available at Our Lady of the Lake College Library. Further, it will be useful in procuring the inexpensive microfiche forms from the National Technical Information Service. It should be noted that this is the "available from source" for over half of the listed non EDRS documents.

These suggestions on "how to use this data" are based on the assumption that there is a quantifiable impact if the documents are not available or if their availability is not readily apparent. So let me conclude by saying that there are 169 non EDRS LI documents and a total of 1125 LI documents listed for the period of this study. This means that up to 15.0% of this non EDRS, Research in Education, LI information may not be available in a given scholarly library science collection. How much is missing from yours?
