ABSIRACT

A follow-up study was conducted of students who received a degree, diploma, or certificate from Austin Community College (ACC) in May 1977 to determine their level of satisfaction; 63% (N=189) of the surveyed group responded. Results were tabulated for the group as a whole and for the following subgroups: these receiving Associate of Arts, Associate in Science, and Associate in Applied Science degrees; those who completed certificates; male and female respondents; and Blacks, Hispanics, and Whites. The survey instrument focused on employment and salary information; ratings of instructional and noninstructional college services, fulfillment of individual needs by courses and programs, and preparation for transfer or employment; relevance of training to job; educational cbjectives and future interest; and transfer problems. Of all respondents, 68% were employed full-time with 64.4% reporting jobs directly or closely related to their area of study. The average wonthly salary of employed graduates was \$866.49; however, the average earnings of female graduates were less than that of males. Cf respondents, over 80% rated quality of instruction and instructor intérest as good or very good. 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INTRODUCTION:

On December 1, 1978 the Office of Placement/Follow-up initiated the first annual follow-up study of graduates (see population definition) May 1977. The follow-up study was initiated in an effort to decermine the level of satisfaction of students who received a degree, diploma, or certificate at the May 1977 Commencement Exercises. The follow-up questionnaire utilized is attached as Appendix A.

COLLECTION OF DATA:

The Flacement/Follow-up Office, in an attempt to meet the Coordinating Board guidelines and data submission deadlines, stillzed two (2) mailouts and two (2) telephone campaigns. A cover letter and survey was mailed on December 1, 1977. On the 3rd of January, a telephone campaign was begun and contact was made



with students who had not responded. These first two efforts produced a 54% response rate. A second mailout and telephone campaign produced another 9% response rate. The cover letter and questionnaires utilized are located in the appendix. Returned questionnaires were then coded for reporting purposes and forwarded to the Coordinating Board on February 8, 1978. A sexual and ethnic breakdown on all non-respondents (excluding undeliverables) cap also be found in the appendix.

ANALYSIS OF DATA:

The completed questionnaires were collected and logged by the follow-up specialist and submitted to the Coordinating Board on February 8, 1978. The Coordinating Board keypunches the data nad programs the material. The Placement/Follow-up Office synthesizes and analyzes the data and presents it in report form for distribution and dissemination to members of the Austin Community College Board, administration, faculty, and staff. The data is also available by individual academic major and can be secured by program leaders and/or instructors.






