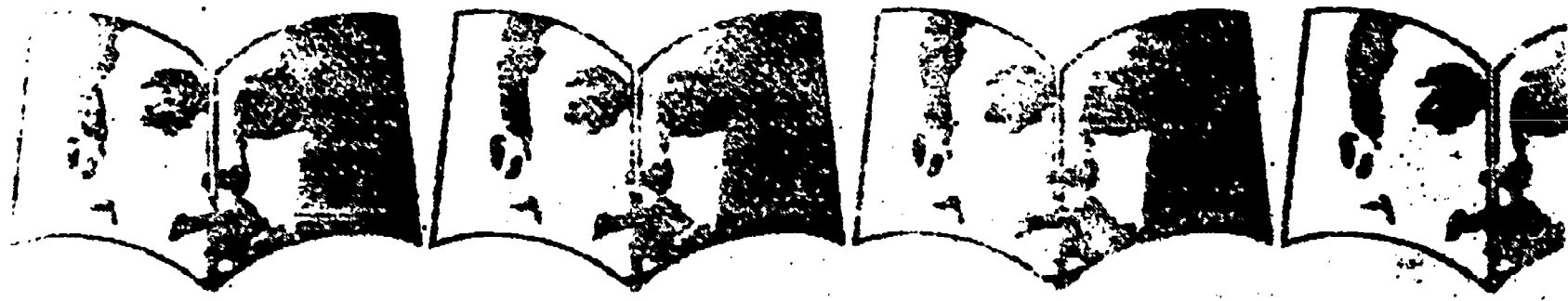

ABSTRACT

Based on findings of Project HAPPIER surveys and intended as a resource for health care providers and educators who serve the migrant community, this guide describes over 375 instructional materials in the areas of dental health, disease control, fitness, health promotion, human growth and development, hypertension, maternal and child care, mental health, nutrition; personal hygiene, and preventative care. Organized under these major topics, each instructional item is listed on a single page along with information about the format, source/producer of the material, reading level, intended users, intended audiences, a brief description of the material, language English and/or Spanish, availability, and cost. Material formats include booklets, audiovisuals, posters, curriculum units, coloring books, and single sheets. The guide covers materials from a wide variety of government and professional organizations and health care products companies. Many materials are free. Although most materials are available in English only, a substantial proportion are in Spanish or Spanish and English, e.g., 14 of 36 dental health materials are available in Spanish. Intended users include parents, teachers, administrators, and health care providers; the range of intended audiences include all ages from young children to teenagers and families. (JHZ)

HAPPIER OVERVIEW

The Pennsylvania Department of Education administers Project HAPPIER, funded through discretionary funds by the United States Department of Education, Office of Migrant Education. The project coordinates an intra/interstate and intra/interagency effort to develop and disseminate materials on the health awareness patterns that prevent illnesses and promote wellness for migrant children.

Funded in September 1983, the Project assembled a consortium of representatives from the state departments of education of Minnesota, Arizona, Illinois, Massachusetts, Georgia, Texas, Washington, Florida, California, and Puerto Rico. Represented as part of the consortium is the United States Department of Education, Migrant Education and the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Migrant Health. Also represented are various health delivery experts who will be used as sources of information on specific preventative and holistic health techniques. This project will be developed cooperatively between health and education persons throughout the nation and at local, state, and federal levels.

Each of these organizations will contribute to the development of materials for migrant children from preschool to grade 12 for the teaching of correct information concerning health practices which promote wellness and the development of a Resource Guide of health education materials.

Field testing of the Resource Guide involving administrators, teachers, and health personnel of migrant children is being planned for California, Texas, Florida, and Puerto Rico. It is anticipated that the project scope will be expanded to allow further refinement of the materials, Resource Guide, training strategies, overall dissemination of the project materials, and the training of migrant teachers and health personnel in additional states.

Project HAPPIER will bring together for the first time the joint expertise of the United States Department of Education (Migrant Education) and the Department of Health and Human Services (Migrant Health) whose primary concern will be the delivery of an effective preventative health curriculum for the benefit of migrant families.

INFORMACION GENERAL SOBRE EL PROYECTO HAPPIER

El Proyecto HAPPIER es administrado por el Departamento de Educación de Pensilvania, con fondos subsidiarios provistos por el Departamento de Educación de los Estados Unidos, a través de la Oficina de Educación para Migrantes. El proyecto coordina un esfuerzo interagencial e interestatal para desarrollar y diseminar materiales relacionados con la prevención de las enfermedades y la enseñanza de los principios relacionados con la salud, con el fin de prevenir las enfermedades y promover el bienestar de los niños migrantes.

Financiado desde septiembre de 1983, el proyecto ha reunido un consorcio de representantes de los departamentos de educación de los siguientes estados: Minnesota, Massachusetts, Georgia, Texas, Washington, Florida, California y Puerto Rico. El consorcio incluye representantes de la oficina de Educación para Migrantes, el Departamento de Educación de los Estados Unidos, el Departamento de Salud y Servicios Humanos de los Estados Unidos y la Oficina de Salud para Migrantes. El consorcio está representado además, por expertos en salud, quienes servirán como fuentes de información en relación a las técnicas preventivas que ayudan a tener una mejor salud. Este proyecto será desarrollado nacionalmente a nivel local, estatal y federal y con la cooperación del personal de educación y salud para migrantes.

Cada una de estas organizaciones contribuirá al desarrollo de los materiales que serán usados para enseñar a los niños migrantes de edad preescolar hasta el grado 12 la información correcta relativa a los principios sobre la salud que promueven el bienestar. La información recibida permitirá el desarrollo de una Guía de Recursos que contenga los materiales educativos sobre la salud que están disponibles.

Maestros, administradores y personal de salud participarán en el entrenamiento que ha sido planeado para los estados de California, Texas, Florida y Puerto Rico, en el uso de la Guía de Recursos Educativos sobre la Salud. Se anticipa una expansión en los objetivos del proyecto para permitir el refinamiento de los materiales, la Guía de Recursos Educativos sobre la Salud, las estrategias ha seguir al entrenar el personal, la diseminación de los materiales y el entrenamiento de los maestros y el personal de salud para migrantes en otros estados.

El Proyecto HAPPIER juntará, por primera vez, la experiencia del Departamento de Educación de los Estados Unidos (Educación para Migrantes) y del Departamento de Salud y Servicios Humanos de los Estados Unidos (Salud para Migrantes) para beneficiar las familias migrantes por medio de hacer provisión de unidades de enseñanza sobre los principios preventivos sobre la salud que promueven el bienestar.

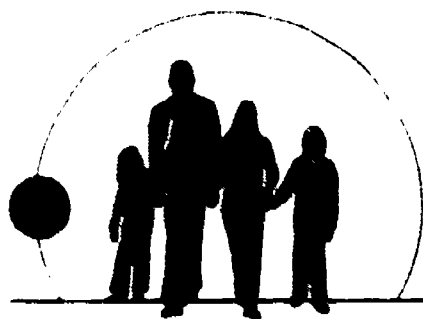
