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## ABSTRACT

This is the fourth annual puolication of profiles of Alaska's public school districts as directed by the State Legislature. The profile format for the 54 school districts and the state total summary is a 2 -page display of data grouped into the following 6 subject headings: (1) background; (2) operating revenues and expenditures; (3) funding community survey; (4) student characteristics; (5) staff ratios and statistics; and (6) staff and student demographics. Sections of the profile are enlarged and annotated to help the reader understand them. State figures indicate that statewide expenditures in Alaska total $\$ 839,974,371$. The average daily student membership of $115,640.8$ is served by a total instructional staff of $8,764.9$. The state totals and 54 district profiles are presented in tabular form. (SLD)

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## Introduction

This is the fourth annual publication of Profiles of Alaska's Public School Districts. The Alaska Legislature in its Fiscal Year 89 authorization, directed the State Department of Education to prepare annual profiles on each school district. İ its directive the Legislature wrole:

It is the intent of the Legislature that the Department of Education will implement a data management system including but not limited to profiles of school districts which include data on scinool operations, facilitics. programs, students and personnel.

In compliance, the Deparment produces this publication on an annual basis. This information is intended to add to the statewide knowledge base and understanding of education in Alaska.

The sumunary of data in this publication represents only a small portion of the statistics contained in the Department's computerized data management system. The District Profile Data Base is a compendium of information gathered from numerous sources. For example, the financial data is gathered from the audited financial reports submitted by school districts in November following each school year. The staff and student data is gathered from enrollment and staff reports submitted by each school district annually, in compliance with state and federal requirements. Other background data, such as employment statistics and population, are gathered from official state and federal govemment sources.

One change has been made in the format and content of this year's publication. Revenue and expenditure data have been included for Mt. Edgecumbe High School and Centralized Correspondence School. Because of the unique expenditure categories for these schools, their totals by category are not included with district category totals (see page 10.) However, a state wide expenditure line has been included just below the district total line that summarizes both school and district totals.

## Content

The profile format for the fifty-four school districts and the Alaska State Total summary is a two page display of data grouped into the following six subject headings:

-Background<br>-Operating Revenues and Expenditures<br>-Funding Community Summary<br>-Student Characteristics<br>-Staif Ratios and Statistics<br>-Staff and Student Demographics

The Profile format for Mt. Edgecumbe High School and Centralized Correspondence School uses four of the above subject headings.

Below is a sample of the format used to report each district's profile. On succeeding pages, sections of the profile are enlarged and annotated to help the reader understand them.

## Sample District



## Background

The background area at the top of the first page provides background on each of the school districts. Some items, such as square miles, originate with state sources while others, such as population, originate with the federal Bureau of the Census.

A. Square Miles: Funding Communities: Attendance Centers: 3 Population: Median Family Income: Per Capita Income: Percent Unemployment Percent of Adults with High School Diploma:


In those instances where data. such as unemployment statistics, per capita income, median family income and adults with a high school diploma were not available at the district level, the percentages and averages from the region of the state in which the school district is localed are reported.
A. Square milics reported at the district level include a significant amount of tidelands and submerged lands scaward to three nautical miles and therefore the sum of district square miles exceeds the total square miles of land reported at the state level.
B. Population counts for the districts do not add to the state total because there is no school district for the community of Hyder. Students in Hyder attend school in British Colunbia.
C. House and Senate election districts reflect the most recent redistricting changes in order to make this publication more useful.

## Operating Revenues and Expenditures

Centrally dispiayed on the first page of each district's profile is the 1991-92 audited financial data. On the Alaska State Total page, the summary totals for the fifty-four school districts, Centralized Correspondence School and Mt. Edgecumbe High School are reported.

D. The figures displayed are 1991-92 audited Operating Revenues and Operating Expenditures only. These data depict the financial characteristics of each districi"s general operations and show the costs to operate schools in the district. Audited data are available six months after the close of each school year.
E. The "S per ADM" column represents Average Daily Membership in grades K-12 only. Districts that have Pre-Elementary students do not include them in the ADM count. Therefore, both revenue and expenditure dollars per ADM in those districts are slightly inflated.
F. Those districts reporting revenue fund "transfers" have had those sums included in the "Other (State)" revenue category.
G. City and borough district "Tuition" totals are included as "Other (State)" revenue.
H. The totals do not include federal supplemental grant funds or restricted use funds such as the Migrant Program. Chapter I, or Handicapped Program funds, because these funds are supplemental to a district's normal operations and are restricted in their use.

A detailed description of each of the Revenue and Expenditure categories can be found in the glossary following the profile series beginning on page 125 .

The state of Alaska Unifonn Chart of Accounts currently provides school districts some latitude in optional function and object code presentations. Totals reported in audits, therefore, do not necessarily represent costs of similar activilies in every case, as many users of the data would desire. For example, administration expenses will not always be found under the function codes for school and district administration. As larger districts employ support staff to run specific operations with their own function codes, the resulting program admninistrative expenses will be found in those function codes and not the school and district administration function codes. The department is considering proposed revisions to the chart of account definitions and structure that would prcvide summary data that meets the needs of state and federal users for specific and comparable data.

## Funding Community Summary

Funding Communitv information displayed at the bottom of the first page provides data on grade levels, facility counts and enrollments. Funding Communities are financial reporing agencies set up under the Alaska Administrative Code as part of the Public School Foundation Program.


In this section of the report, district operated correspondence study programs are listed as separate Funding Comınunities so that their enrollments could be shown accurately. However, according to state law, district correspondence programs are assigned to the funding community with the highest Average Daily Membership. Accordingly, the total count of funding communitics appearing in the "Background" section does not include the correspondence prograns.

## Student Characteristics

Student data are reported in several different ways.

I. The Average Daily Membership full-time equivalent number may differ from the total enrollment listed in the previous Funding Community Summary section. Average Daily Membership (ADM) is based on an average of counts taken each day over a prescribed twenty-day period while enrollment is a single day count.
J. The item "Special Necds" is a total of those students repored by the districts in three classifications: "Resources," "Self Contained," or "Intensive."
K. These counts are the number of students scrved under the Migrant and Chapter 1 Programs as reported by the program's annual evaluation forms submitted by each district.
L. Poverty level data are not universally available for all districts. Most poverty data are obtained from the number of students who qualified for the Federal Government's free and reduced lunch program. When a District did not participate, a poverty estimate was obtained, if available. from the Departunent of Education Chapter I records.
M. Vocational Education is offered only in grades nine through twelve and. consequently, is shown as a percentage of the enrollinent for those four grades only.

## Staff Ratios and Statistics

Centrally displayed on the second page are ratios and statistics relating to the district and school staff.

N. ADM is not reported for pre-elementary and the Herman Hutchens Special Education School in Valdez. Therefore ratios will be slightly lower in some districts.
O. Stafftotals are displayed as Full-Time Equivalents (FTE). Often a staff member will work part time in some positions, which results in some FTE numbers appearing as fractions, cven in such areas as gender and ethnicity.
P. The definition of"fulltime" may vary from district to district, particularly for Instructional Aides. For exanple, some districts define a work day as a five-and-one-half-hour day while others define a work day as an eight-hour day.

## Staff and Student Demographics

Staff ard Student information displayed at the bottom of the second page provides data by gender and ethnicity. Small differences may occur in totals when summing due to rounding.

Q. Instructional Aides by ethnicity may not equal the TOTAL due to some districts' not reporting ethnicity.
R. The student demographics shown here under the column "Student Enrolment" are head counts, while the "Total" is Full-Time Equivalents. Thercfore, there may be slight variations in totals.

Beginning on page 125 is a glossary of terms listed in alphabetical order. The reader is encouraged to refer to this glossary for additional explanation of data elements included in these profiles.

## Methodology

All data gathered for this publication were either submitted to the Department of Education in official reports from the school districts, or in the case of background information, taken from reports published by official state ond federiu sources. Therefore, this data base is a compendium of data originally gathered elsewhere and brought together for this display.

Columns containing percentages have been computed from the figures provided to the Department by the school districts, but may not total $100 \%$ due to rounding. Percentages for numbers less than $.1 \%$ have been rounded to $.1 \%$ unless insignificant.

Not every district participates in every program displayed here. Therefore, some districts have areas of blank data ficlds, which indicates either the district does not par::ipate in the program or did not report the particular data.

## Glossary of Terms

## Administrarive Expenditures

Expenses that pertain to the activities of both school and district administration. At the school level, it includes the activities performed by the principal, assistant principal and other assistants in general supervision of administrative operations of the school. At the district level. it includes administration of the schools and the school system, as well as activities relating to school board matters. It should be noted that the Chart of Accounts allows for program adininistration expenses to be charged to other function codes in addition to the school and district administration function codes

## All Teachers

This term refers to a summary of those centified teachers including visiting teachers, in remedial or consulting roles to meet special student nceds in classrooms, and in a teaching capacity as a head teacher. Information reported s on a full-time equivalent basis.

## Area Cost Differential

A multiplier factor as shown in AS 14.17.05I to adjust a school district's instructional units for cost differentials between school districts. Factors vary between 1.0 and 1.46 , depending usually on remoteness of the district.

## Attendance Centers

A school, operated by a district, serving one or more grade levels of students or special education, vocational education, or bilingual/bicultural students as defined by 4 AAC 09.105 for foundation funding purposes. District correspondence programs and programs where enrollments are counted at other schools are not included.

## Average Daily Membership

The average of the number of students enrolled over a twenty-day period on a full-time equivalent basis, as speciffed by AS 14.17.160. It is reported to the department in the district's initial Foundation Report by the end of the second week following the fourth Friday in October and updated at mid-year if the numbers of students increase dramatically. Districts report ADM for grades K-12 only.

## BilinguallBicultural Students

Students who are determined by a district to be bilingual as defined by 4 AAC 34.050 .

## Building Administrators

Principals and assistant principals are in this category along with head teachers that spend some portion of their time on administrative duties.

## Central Office Staff

District personnel that provide aciainistrative services for the school district. Examples of central office staff are superintendents, assistant superintendents, directors, managers, and administrative assistants. Contact the Office of Data Management for a complete listing by job code.

## Chapter I Students

Students whose educational attainunent is below the level appropriate for children of their age as defined by 34 CFR Part 200, U.S. Department of Education Regulations.

## Classroom Teacher

A regular, certified classroom instructor under contract to a state recognized school district to provide formal instruction within a specified time period.

## Election District

The State of Alaska is divided into forty clection districts. Each election district has one representative. Therc are twenty senators, each one representing two of these election districts.

## Enroliment

For reporting purposes, enrollment is the number of students on a full-time equivalent basis that is listed on the membership role in a school for instruction. October 1 is the designated fall count date.

## Foundation Revenues

Revenues accruing to the school district from the state and based on a formula that guarantees each district $\$ 60,000$ per instructional unit, taking into consideration revenue from federal sources and local contributions.

## Full-Time Equivalent (students)

The number of classes in which a student is receiving instruction divided by the number of class periods in a day. This measurement is expressed as a decimal fraction to the nearest tenth.

## Full-Time Equivalent (reachers)

That portion of the total teaching assignment for an individual teacher allocated to a particular subject matter. It is derived by dividing the amount of employcd time normally required of a staff member to perform a less - al full-ime assignunent divided by the amount of time normally required in performing a corresponding fulltime assignment. For example. if a teacher is employed full time, the FTE is 1.0 . If a teacher is employed half time, the FTE is .5 . This measure of time is expressed as a decimal fraction to the nearest tenth.

## Fundi ${ }^{\text {g Communitics }}$

Each school district is divided into funding communitics by attendance centers, a financial reporting entity as defined in 4 AAC 09.005 that gives consideration to centralization and to grade levels involved. In this report. district operated correspondence study programs are listed as separate funding communities although according to state law they are assigned to the funding community with the highest A verage Daily Membership. The total count of funding communities appearing in the." Background "section does not include the correspondence programs.

## Gified/Talented Students

Students identified as exceptional as defined in AS 14.30.350.(a), detcrmined eligible under 4 AAC 52.130, and warranting special advanced instruction as required in 4 ACC 52.140, and reported for Foundation funding.

## Governance

System of government at the local level as provided for in the Alaska Constitution. Currently, there are three unified homerule governments, eleven organized boroughs, ene hundred fory-ninc incorporated communities. one community organized under federal law, and twenty-one Regional Education Attendance Areas. School districts have been established in each of the municipalities, boroughs, REAA's and nineteen of the incorporated communities.

## High School Graduates

Students recciving a high school diploma or a certificate of completion during the school year.

## Instructional Aides

Staff members assigned to assist a teacher in activities requiring minor decisionsregarding students and in such activities as monitoring, conducting rote exercises, operating equipment and record keeping.

Instructional Expenditures
Instructional Expenditures include those operating expenses for: Regular Instruction, Vocational Education. CorrespondenceStudy, Special Education. Gifted and Talented Education, and Bilingual-Bicultural Education. As compiled from annual audits, this category excludes categorical grant funds restricted in use.

## Instructional Units

Basic unit of measure upon which the state School Foundation Program funding is based and calculated from student Average Daily Membership identified for grade levels K through 12, with additional weighting for vocational, special education.gifted/talented, and bilingual programs and adjusted by the area cost differential. according to AS 14.17.041-47.

## Local Sources Revenue

Revenue collected by cities and boroughs and appropriated to the school board for school purposes and revenue produced within the school system for school purposes. The city and borough school districts are, under state law, required to contribute the lesser amount of: (1) the equivalent of funds generated by a four mill tax levy based on the full and true value of the taxable real and personal property in the school district; or (2) 35 percent of a school district's basic need for the preceding school year.

## Median Family Income

Income by family derived from the 1990 Census and undated on an annual basis with Bureau of the Census income data and Department of Commerce employment and eamings data. Family is deinined as 2 or more persons related by blood or marriage. Median income is the amount that divides the distribution of families into two equal groups, one having incomes above the median and the other having incomes below the median.

## Migrant Education Students

Students who within the last six ycars have moved across school district boundaries because their parents are involved in seasonal or temporary employment in fishing. logging or agriculture activities as defined in 34 CFR Part 201. Migrant numbers in this repori are unduplicated counts of migrant students served during the regular and summer terms combined as reported by the districts on their annual evaluation form.

## Operation and Maintenance

Expenses of plant facilitics, which includes such items as utilities, janitorial services, painting, and repairs.

## Other Expenditures

Expenses relating to Community Services, Tuition, Fund Transfers and Pupil Activities.

## Other (Federal) Revenue

Federal revenue other than PL 874 revenue such as indirect cost revenue for administration of grants.

## Other (State) Revenue

State revenues that cannot be classified in the nine other state revenue categories as described in the Uniform Chart of Accounts and include such items as legislative grants.

## Per Capifa Income

The total personal income of an area divided by the arca's resident population (every rran, women and child). This information is published on an annual basis by the federal Bureau of Economic Analysis, an agency of the U.S. Department of Commerce.

## Percent of ADM

Percentage derived by dividing student counts for cach category of program service by the Average Daily Membership on a full-time equivalent basis.

## Percent of Adults with High School Diploma

Percent of persons 25 and over completing four years high school or more from the 1980 Census.

## PL-874 Revenuc

Federal funds (Federal Law PL-874, Impact Aid to Education) provided to school districts for children of parents living and/or working on federal property as an "in lieu of local tax" revenue, including land conveyed to Native Corporations under the Alaska Native Claims Settleınent Act. Under Federal law the State may deduct a portion of these revenues from the State's aid to school districts as long as the State insures equality in funding to all students across the State.

## Population

District population counts are developed by the Alaska Department of Labor based on the 1990 U.S. Census data.

## Poverty Level Students

Students who participated in the federal Free and Reduced Luncn Program. as reported to the State Department of Education in November. As not all districts choose to participate in the program, a poverty estimatcobtained from Departunent of Education Chapter I records was used for non-participants, and in some cases supplemented by best estiniates supplied by the district.

## Pupil Staff Ratio

Ratio computed by dividing the student Average Daily Membership by the number of full-time equivalent staff positions in cach category.

## Pupil Support Expenditures

Expenses incurred in pupil support activities such as school office, health, library, student activities, and usually not related to direct instruction.

## Regional Corporations

Twelve regional corporations were crealed in 1971 by the Alaska Native Claims Sctlement Act to accept payment from the Fedcral Govemment in exchange forall aboriginal titles and claims of title in Alaska. These corporations were based on twelve geographic regions that approximated the areas covered by the operations of existing Native associations. A thirteenth region and regional comporation was also established for Natives who were non-residents of Alaska.

## Specialists

Individuals in non-teaching and non-administrative job code positions. They are individuals who perform services of a specialized nature. Examples of this category would be audiologists. physical or occupational therapists, psychologists, nurses, counselors, and librarians. ## Special Needs Students

Monthly estimatespublished by the Alaska Departmentor Labor by Census Area. School districts are assigned the same figures for the applicable census area.

## Vocational Education Students

Students in a non-degree secondary school training program that prepares them for entry level employment or advancement in an occupation requiring less than a baccalaureate degree as defined by 4 AAC 51.190.
