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ABSTRACT

This report presents data, collected from 3,532 institutions of higher education within the 50 states and the District of Columbia, concerning the number of degrees conferred by these accredited institutions over the 10-year period from 1980-81 to 1989-90. Primary data sources were the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS) for 1980-81 through 1984-85 and the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) for 1986-87 through 1989-90. Tables of data, comprising 85 percent of the report, list the following information: (1) numbers and percentages of degrees conferred by level of degree and sex without regard to race/ethnicity; (2) numbers and percentages of degrees conferred by level of degree and race/ethnicity without regard to sex; (3) numbers of degrees conferred and average annual percentage change by level of degree and field of study without regard to sex or race/ethnicity; (4) numbers of degrees conferred by sex, race/ethnicity, and field of study. In addition, individual tables present the same type of data specific to each level of degree (i.e., associate's, bachelor's, master's, doctor's, and first professional). The appendix provides the total number of associate's, bachelor's, master's, and doctor's degrees conferred in 1989-90, by detailed program specialty and summarized to the discipline division. (GLR)

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Introduction

This report presents data on degrees conferred by the nation's accredited higher education institutions over the 10-year period from 1980-81 to 1989-90. The data are from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) 1986-87 through 1989-90 Completions and 1990 Consolidated surveys; and the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS), 1980-81 through 1984-85, "Degrees and Other Formal Awards Conferred in Institutions of Higher Education." These surveys collected information on degrees conferred by level of award (associate's, bachelor's, master's, doctor's, first-professional), race/ethnicity and sex of recipients, and major field of study.

This report is one of a series of E.D. TABS published by the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) designed primarily to make data available to the public with minimal analysis. It presents information on institutions of higher education, which are accredited at the college level by an agency recognized by the Secretary, U.S. Department of Education. This E.D. Highlights

- The share of degrees awarded to women at each degree level has shown steady growth throughout the period of this report. Since 1984-85, women have accounted for over half of the awards at each degree level through master's, with their highest share always at the associate level (table 1).
- Except for first-professional degrees to men, the number of degrees awarded to both men and women at every level increased from 1988-89 to 1989-90. The number of men receiving first-professional degrees in 1989-90 declined 2.7 percent from 1988-89 to 43,819, continuing a decline over the entire period of this report (table 1).
- Associate's degrees increased 3.9 percent between 1988-89 and 1989-90 (from 432,144 to 448,997). Most of the increase was accounted for by women (table 1).

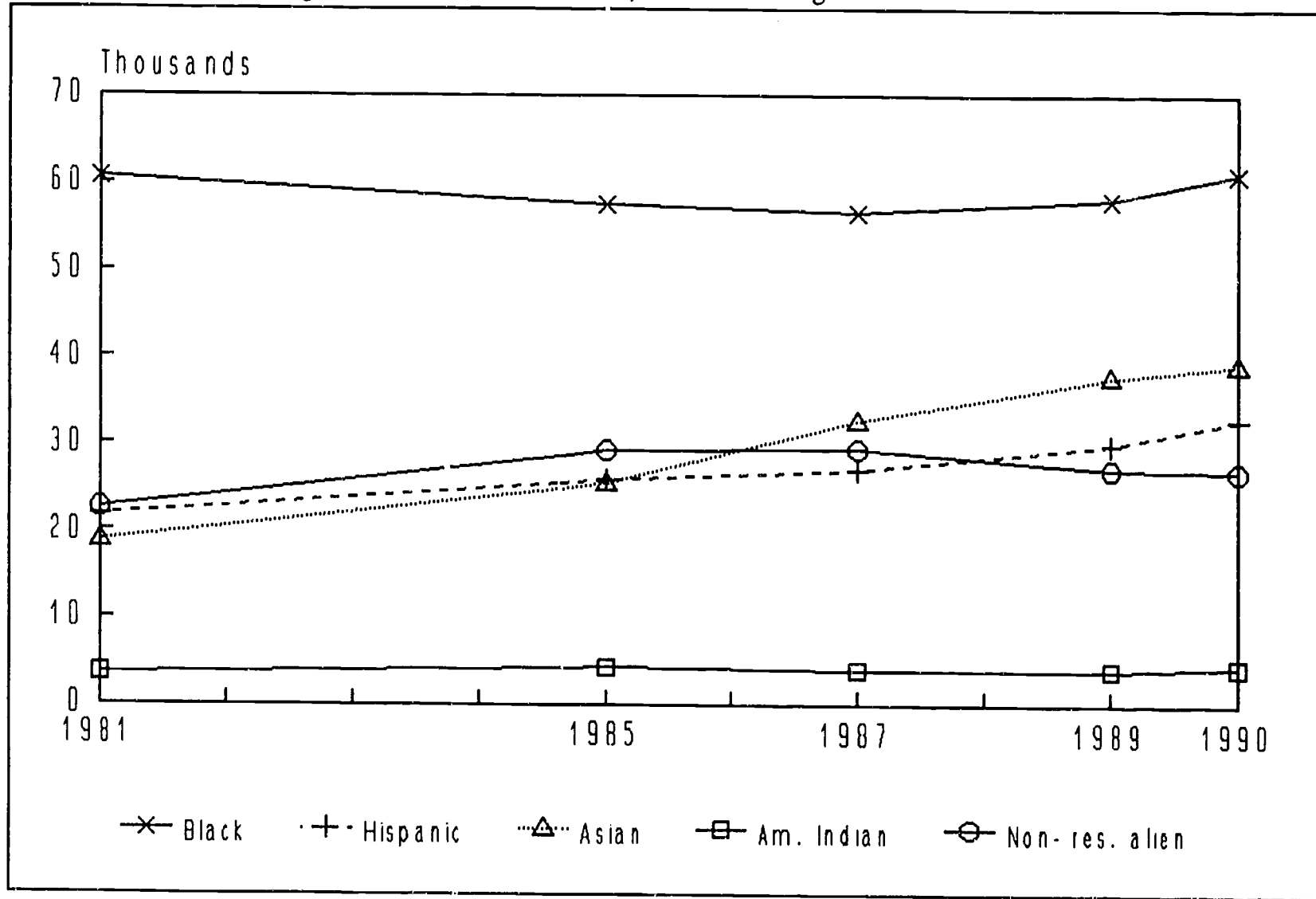


Figure 2.--Bachelor's degrees awarded by racial/ethnic category, 1980-81

- The number of bachelor's degrees awarded to black, non-Hispanics in 1989-90 has increased slightly since 1980-81, following a mild decline in the mid-1980s. However, over the same period, blacks received a decreasing share of the bachelor's degrees awarded to minorities — down from 48 percent in 1980-81 to a 37 percent share in 1989-90 (table 2 and figures 1, 2, and 3).
- The number of master's and doctor's degrees awarded to non-resident aliens over the period of this report has steadily increased and has remained larger than any racial/ethnic category, excluding white, non-Hispanics. For 1989-90, non-resident aliens accounted for 11 and 23 percent respectively of total master's and doctor's degrees awarded (table 2).
- For each of the five years in this report, the most prevalent fields of study among bachelor's degree recipients have remained Business and management, Social sciences, Education, Engineering and related technologies, and Health professions. (table 3).

Figure 1. Bachelor's degrees awarded to minorities, 1980-81 through 1989-90

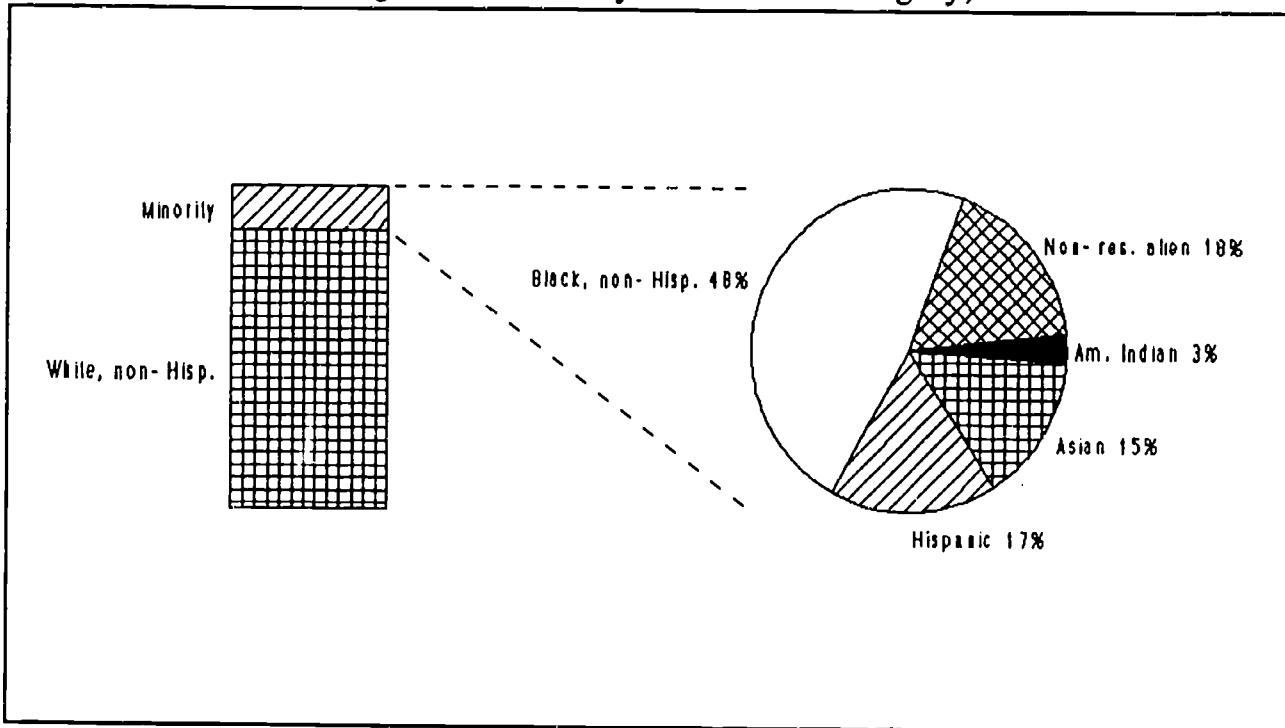


Figure 3.--Bachelor's degrees awarded by racial/ethnic category, 1989-90

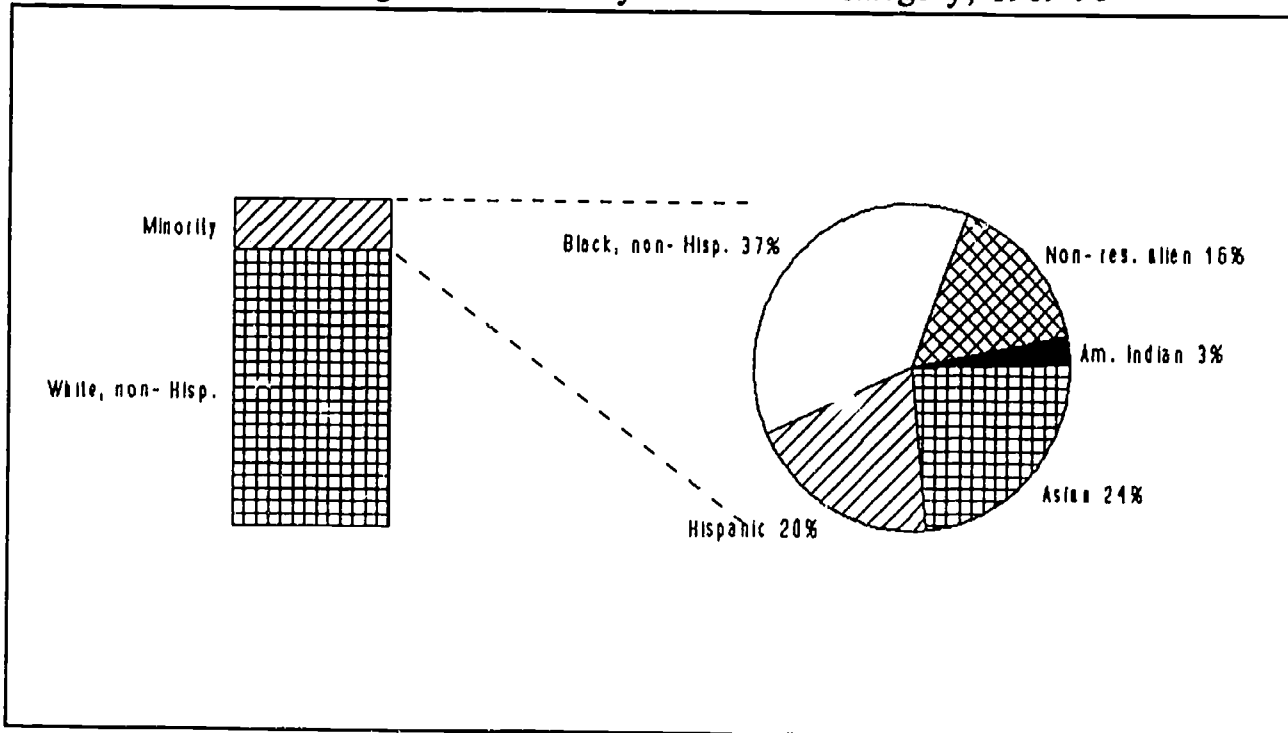


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Data Sources

The primary sources for this publication were "Degrees and Other Formal Awards Conferred in Institutions of Higher Education," a component of HEGIS, for academic years through 1984-85, and "Completions," a component of IPEDS, for subsequent years. These two surveys had nearly identical structures concerning data collected, the primary difference being the range of institutions surveyed. HEGIS surveys were restricted to institutions of higher education which are accredited at the college level by an agency recognized by the Secretary, U.S. Department of Education, while IPEDS coverage has been expanded to include all postsecondary institutions. Since this report is limited to institutions of higher education, the two surveys may be considered identical. For academic year 1989-90, an additional IPEDS survey, "Consolidated Survey," (CN) collected completions data along with enrollment, finances, and academic libraries. While the portion of this form dealing with completions differs from the Completions survey, it was designed to result in compatible information, and 30 institutions receiving the CN form are included in this report.

Prior to the 1989-90 survey, racial/ethnic data were collected biennially. For this reason, the years presented in this report are not consecutive. In addition, data for 1982-83 were not available.

In HEGIS surveys before 1984-85, data on the number of associate degrees awarded by the racial/ethnic categories of the degree recipients were not collected separately for each discipline division. Also, associate degrees were combined with certificates below the baccalaureate level in those early surveys. Therefore, it is not possible to present data on associate degrees awarded by field or racial/ethnic category for 1980-81 in this report.

Discipline divisions (fields of study) are specified in the Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) categories which was developed by NCES and is the federally accepted standard for collecting, reporting, and interpreting education program data. Beginning with the 1982-83 survey of earned degrees, the CIP has been used for classifying degree fields. Data for 1980-81 were collected under a different classification system but were converted to the CIP format to allow consistent presentation for the period of this report.

Scope

The Completions 1989-90 survey was mailed to 3,932 institutions including: 3,620 accredited institutions (i.e., those accredited at the college level by an agency recognized by the Secretary, U.S. Department of Education); plus 312 schools that do not have recognized accreditation but do award bachelor's, master's, doctor's or first-professional degree. The C1 survey form was mailed to 2,506 schools offering at least a baccalaureate degree, and the C2 survey form was sent to 1,426 schools offering a degree or certificate requiring less than four years. In addition, the CN survey form was mailed to 2,998 postsecondary schools offering degrees or awards ranging from less than one year to post-master's certificates.

Data included in this report, a subset of the above counts, are for the 3,532 institutions of higher education, located within the 50 states and the District of Columbia only. These institutions have been accredited at the college level by an agency recognized by the Secretary, U.S. Department of Education. Formerly known as HEGIS institutions, they were surveyed on a census basis, and their response rate has historically remained high. Their overall response rate for 1989-90 was 92.3 percent.

Editing

During editing, all forms were checked for CIP code validity and addition errors. Total lines were generated and compared to the reported totals for each 2-digit discipline division. Any difference which appeared to be larger than a simple arithmetic error were referred to the institution in an attempt to resolve the discrepancy. Other differences were resolved by replacing the reported total with the generated total and setting a corresponding imputation flag.

The data for each institution were also checked for consistency with its prior year's response, when available. The institution was contacted for verification when data appeared inconsistent.

The overall response rate was calculated as the ratio of the number of completed survey forms divided by the number of in-scope schools (i.e., the number mailed minus the number determined to be out-of-scope). Any institution was considered a respondent if it supplied total awards by sex.

Imputations

Two stages of imputations had to be performed for the higher education data contained in this report. The first stage concerned total nonrespondents to the 1989-90 survey (7.7 percent of the institutions.) In those cases where data from the institution's previous years' survey response were available, these data were used; an indicator flag on the data file identifies schools imputed by this procedure. As a result, only four institutions were left without any information. Two of these were 4-year institutions, one private nonprofit and one private for-profit. Another was a public 2-year institution, and the final was a private for-profit less than 2-year institution.

The second stage of imputation dealt with item nonresponse. In particular, some institutions were not able to completely report the race/ethnicity of award recipients. In these cases, the unreported racial/ethnic counts (computed as the difference between the reported total and the sum of reported racial/ethnic categories) were proportionately distributed among the known U.S. totals of racial/ethnic categories by 2-digit program areas. The number of awards distributed in this manner were 20,512 associate's degrees; 10,042 bachelor's degrees; 7,104 master's degrees; 449 doctor's degrees; and 9 first-professional degrees. These represented 4.6, 1.0, 2.2, 1.2, and less than 0.1 percent, respectively, of the totals for associate's, bachelor's, master's, doctor's, and first-professional awards.

With the 1989-90 survey, IPEDS began to collect an additional race/ethnicity category, "Race/ethnicity unknown." This category is used only if the student does not select a racial/ethnic designation and the institution finds it impossible to place the student into one of the other categories during the established enrollment procedures or in any post-enrollment identification or verification process. Since counts for this category were not collected in previous years, those data were also distributed among the other U.S. racial/ethnic categories by 2-digit program areas for this report. However, since the "Race/ethnicity unknown" category is restricted to U.S. citizens and resident aliens, this distribution excluded "Non-resident alien" counts. The number of awards distributed in this manner were 9,758 associate's degrees; 20,741 bachelor's degrees; 10,503 master's degrees; 880 doctor's degrees; and 1,038 first-professional degrees. These represented 2.2, 2.0, 3.3, 2.3, and 1.5 percent, respectively, of the totals for associate's, master's, doctor's, and first-

professional awards. When this new category has been collected for a sufficient period of time to allow meaningful trends to appear, those data will be added to the report categories.

In addition, there were some institutions that did not report the field of study for award recipients. These data (5,682 associate's; 2,727 bachelor's; 1,852 master's; 258 doctor's; and 244 first-professional degrees) were removed from the analysis. Thus, the numbers in this publication are slight undercounts of actual awards at these degree levels.

Imputation for total nonrespondents has remained basically the same over the period of this report. Prior to 1986-87, imputations for unreported race/ethnicity was not performed and those counts are not included in totals presented in this report. For subsequent years, the imputation procedures as described above, other than the distribution of "Race/ethnicity unknown" counts, were used.

Explanation of Tables

Table 1 displays the number and percentage of degrees conferred by level of degree and sex without regard to race/ethnicity.

Table 2 provides the number and percentage of degrees conferred by level of degree and race/ethnicity without regard to sex.

Table 3 shows the number of degrees conferred and average annual percent change by level of degrees and field of study without regard to sex or race/ethnicity. This table does not include first-professional degrees due to the limited fields in which they are awarded.

Tables 4 through 8 show the number of degrees conferred by sex, race/ethnicity, and field of study. Each table is confined to one of the levels of degrees (Table 4 - Associate's; Table 5 - Bachelor's; Table 6 - Master's; Table 7 - Doctor's; Table 8 - First-professional.)

The Appendix gives the total number of associate's, bachelor's, master's, and doctor's degrees conferred in 1989-90, by detailed program specialty, as well as summarized to the discipline division.

Late responses and corrections received too late to be included in the 1988-89 IPEDS Completions survey were incorporated into a new data file, which was used for this publication. Therefore, some data in this report for academic year 1988-89 will be different from previous publications.

Certain aggregations of the discipline division fields as reported in the IPEDS Completions survey have been made for the tables showing field of study. Figure 4 will allow users to determine which discipline divisions are included in those fields of study; fields of study not listed are identical to the IPEDS discipline division.

In analyzing data by fields of study, users must remember that the data represent programs, not schools, colleges, or divisions (SCDs) within institutions. For example, some institutions might have a few computer and information science programs organized and taught within a business school. However, for IPEDS reporting purposes, the degrees are classified and counted within the computer and information science discipline division. Therefore, the data represent programs, not organizational units within institutions.
